→ archetypes are innate, universal prototypes for ideas and may be used to interpret observations, actions and outcomes.

→ archetypes are universal experiences, personalities and emotions, resulting in recognizable and typical patterns of behaviour with certain probable outcomes.

→ a character, place, thing or theory that is repeatedly present in films.

→ archetypes are important to folklore, ancient mythology, literature and modern narratives across disciplines (i.e., storytelling).

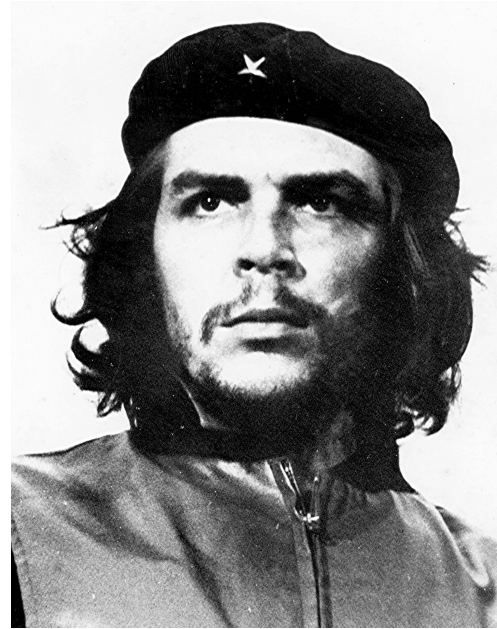
