1. *Case Citation, Side Represented, & Student Names*
2. *Fact T-Chart / Ladder / Grid – CO-AUTHORED*

Accepted Facts	Disputed Facts

5. *Cross Examination — Witness Role (e.g., CW#1, CW#2, DW#1, or DW#2) — Student Name*

Include a transcript of (Q) your actual witness questions, (AR) the anticipated response, and (P) the purpose of each question.

e.g.,

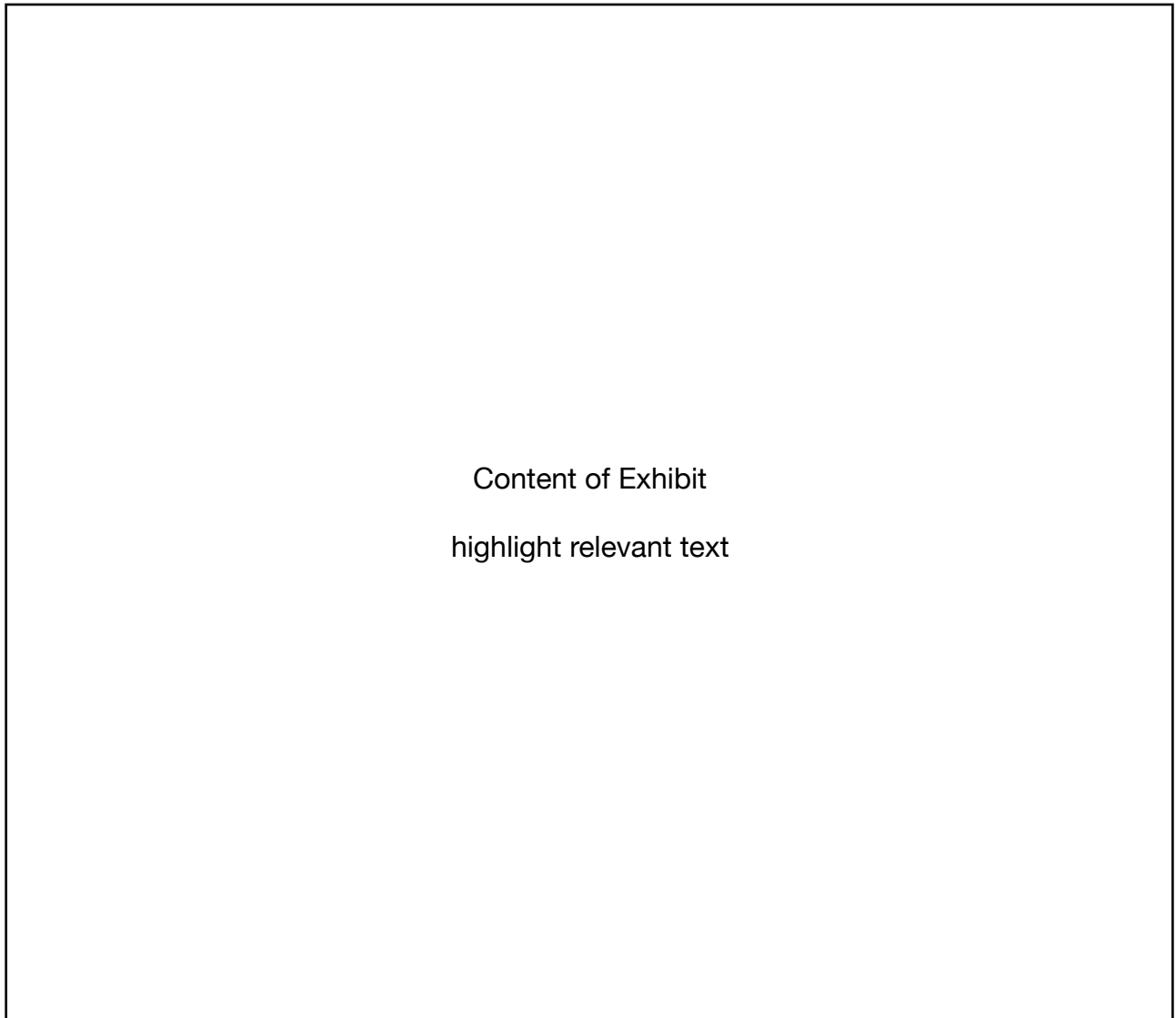
Q1. Question number one.

AR. Anticipated response to question number one.

P. Stated purpose of question one, including question sequence, method and type of attack, content of question in relation to facts and/or law.
